Background

Nebraska State Law requires that acquisition of property must be approved by City Council. The Utilities Department needs to acquire an easement relative to the property of Galen E. and Tamera M. Gerdes, located through a part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW ¼, SE ¼) Section Seven (7), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Eight (8) West of the 6th P.M., Merrick County, Nebraska (163 "A" Road), in order to have access to install, upgrade, maintain, and repair power appurtenances, including lines and transformers.

Discussion

Galen and Tamera Gerdes are in the process of building a new home in rural Merrick County. The proposed easement will permit the Utilities Department to install, operate, and maintain the high voltage power lines and transformer necessary to serve the property.

Alternatives

It appears that the Council has the following alternatives concerning the issue at hand. The Council may:

- 3. Postpone the issue to future date
- 4. Take no action on the issue

Recommendation
