Background

On August 3, 2017 the Wastewater Division of the Public Works Department advertised for bids for Sanitary Sewer Manhole Geospatial Data Collection Phases 3 & 4. A bid solicitation was also sent to eight (8) potential bidders.

The collection of this geospatial data for the City's sanitary sewer system will improve the accuracy and completeness of the digital sanitary sewer collection system features and attributes housed within the City's Geographical Information System (GIS) database. The mapping will also give the City information on locations and elevations of all sanitary sewer structures. This information will be utilized for wastewater capital improvement planning. This survey will provide an accurate, electronic, easily-accessible sanitary sewer system map and GIS database from which the staff can quickly access valuable physical and historical information.

Discussion

Two (2) bids were received and opened on August 22, 2017. The Wastewater Division of the Public Works Department and the Purchasing Division of the City Attorney's office have reviewed the bids that were received. A summary of the bids is shown below.

Funds for the consulting services are in the approved 2016/2017 Wastewater Division budget.

The contract agreement will be for surveying approximately 1,732 sanitary sewer structures at \$51.00 each, resulting in a total amount of \$88,332.00.
