Our building's namesake is Edith Abbott, who became the first woman dean in the School of Social Services at the University of Chicago 1924-1942, and the first dean of a graduate school in an American University. Her bequest was instrumental in the construction of the Edith Abbott Memorial Library in 1974. Her legacy lives on with an expansion of our facility in 2007 and plans underway for needed improvements to serve us well into the future.

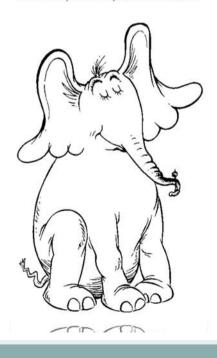

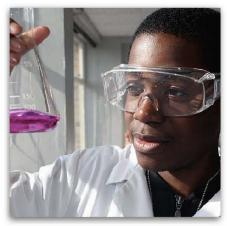

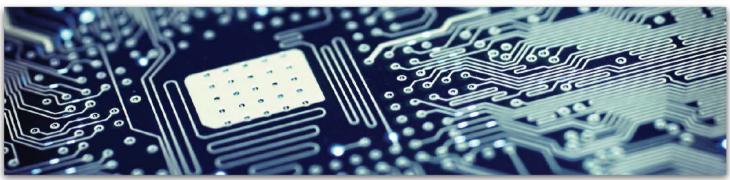

2. Abbott Sisters Day (March 20)

We had a very successful open house and program on Sunday, March 19 to celebrate the Abbott Sisters, their family and their connections to Nebraska 150. Hall County Historical Society, Prairie Pioneer Genealogical Society and Stuhr Museum partnered with the Library in featuring our Abbott and Nebraska 150 related services and resources. The open house runs 1:30—4:00 pm with an educational program starting at 2:00 pm in the Library's meeting room.

Proclaimed statewide, Abbott Sisters Day is an integral part of this community's Abbott Sisters Project. The goal of both efforts is to raise public awareness of the lives and achievements of Edith and Grace Abbott, natives of Grand Island, who achieved international renown as educators, social reformers, and authors. We celebrate so that these important women may continue to influence policy on children's and immigrants' issues and so that their story may serve as an inspiration to future generations. This year we received a proclamation from Governor Ricketts, and Mayor Jensen presented the city's proclamation to Alan Lepler at the March 14 Council meeting.

Our building's namesake is Edith Abbott, who became the first woman dean in the School of Social Services at the University of Chicago 1924-1942, and the first dean of a graduate school in an American University. Her bequest was instrumental in the construction of the Edith Abbott Memorial Library in 1974. Her legacy lives on with an expansion of our facility in 2007 and plans underway for needed improvements to serve us well into the future.

As part of Abbott Sisters Day, our library has a new online book club called "Reading with the Abbott Sisters of Grand Island". Go to our webpage at www.gilibrary.org and click on this graphic. From there you can sign up for our reading club. "Recollections of a Pioneer Lawyer" by O. A. Abbott is on top of your reading list. Published in 1929, this work originally appeared in Nebraska History, Vol. 11 (1928), published by the Nebraska State Historical Society, and we have been given permission by the Nebraska State Historical Society to reproduce online. We keep adding other historical texts and images to our online book club. As

We treasure her commitment to the library!

We sat with Senator Dan Quick and provided him with information about library services and early childhood literacy.

Discussion of FY 2017-18 Budget Process

City administration has indicated a \$150,000 cut in the library budget will be necessary in the coming fiscal year in order to balance the city's budget. The understanding at this point is that the net effect would be less because projected increases in personnel costs would then be added to our budget.
