Mayor Jensen called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm. The Nebraska Open Meetings Act was acknowledged and roll call was taken. Mayor Jensen acknowledged the fact that Wes Wahlgren, NDOT District 4 Engineer, was the designee for Kyle Schneweis, Director of the Nebraska Department of Transportation.

#### Approval of minutes from the February 27, 2018 Policy Board Meeting

Motion by Quandt to approve the minutes from the December 12, 2018 meeting, seconded by Lanfear. Upon roll call vote, all voted in favor. Motion adopted.

#### **Election of Vice-Chair**

O'Neill nominated Quandt as Vice-Chair. Quandt nominated O'Neill as Vice-Chair. With no further nominations for Vice-Chair a roll call vote was conducted.

Jensen, Donaldson, Paulick, Lanfear, O'Neill and Wahlgren cast votes for Quandt.

Quandt cast a vote for O'Neill.

Quandit was elected as Vice-Chair with majority of votes.

## **MPO Financial Update**

Zafft provided a financial update for State Fiscal Year 2018-Second Quarter (October 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017).

### **Approval of MPO Targets for Safety Performance Measures**

Zafft notified the Policy Board that the MPO must adopt safety performance measure targets by February 27, 2018, to be in compliance with the requirement to establish such within 180 days of the State DOT's measures which were adopted August 31, 2017. GIAMPO staff recommended supporting the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) safety performance targets which consist of Number of Fatalities, Rate of Fatalities, Number of Serious Injuries, Rate of Serious Injuries, and Number of Non-Motorized Fatalities and Non-Motorized Serious Injuries. Zafft went over the NDOT safety performance targets for FY 2018, and he provided information on the Number of Fatalities, Number of Serious Injuries, and Number of Non-Motorized Fatalities and Non-Motorized Serious Injuries in the GIAMPO planning in comparison to the State and Hall County from 2012 to 2016. Zafft mentioned that the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) approved the recommendation to support the NDOT safety performance targets at its February 12, 2018 meeting. Jensen questioned why GIAMPO wouldn't support the State measures, with Wahlgren supporting the same. Zafft confirmed the targets would be adopted with the no consequences to the MPO if the numbers are not met.

Motion by Quandt to adopt the Nebraska Department of Transportation Safety Performance Targets, seconded by Lanfear. Upon roll call vote, all voted in favor. Motion adopted.
