#### **Background**

Nebraska State Law requires that acquisition of property must be approved by City Council. The Utilities Department needs to acquire utility easement relative to the property of Leo and Jeanne Mettenbrink, through a part of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter (N <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, NE <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>), Section Sixteen (16), Township Twelve (12) North, Range Nine (9) West of the 6th PM, in Hall County, Nebraska (6950 S. Paul Road), in order to have access to install, upgrade, maintain, and repair power appurtenances, including lines and transformers.

#### **Discussion**

There is an existing power line located on the property at 6950 Saint Paul Road that needs to be upgraded. The proposed easement will allow the Utilities Department to install, access, operate and maintain the power line, transformer and related electrical infrastructure which serve the area.

### **Alternatives**

It appears that the Council has the following alternatives concerning the issue at hand. The Council may:

- 1. Make a motion to approve
- 2. Refer the issue to a Committee
- 3. Postpone the issue to future date
- 4. Take no action on the issue

### **Recommendation**
