Background

The Sycamore Street underpass was built in 1950 and engineering analysis has identified a number of repairs and replacements which must be implemented to preserve the structure. This includes a number of issues related to the retaining walls, the South Front Street Bridge, and the storm sewer pumping system.

On July 26, 2018 the Engineering Division of the Public Works Department advertised for bids for Sycamore Street Underpass Rehabilitation; Project No. 2017-U-1. There were twenty (20) potential bidders for this project.

Discussion

Two (2) bids were received and opened on August 16, 2018. The bids were submitted in compliance with the contract, plans and specifications. A summary of the bids is shown below.
