Background

Vontz Paving, Inc. of Hastings, Nebraska was awarded a \$101,075.50 contract by the City Council on June 12, 2018, via Resolution No. 2018-163, for the second 2018 Annual Asphalt Resurfacing project. This work involved resurfacing the section of Old Highway 2 from Broadwell Avenue to just west of Webb Road, which was used as the detour route for the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) improvements to US Highway 281; south of US Highway 30, north to Chapman Road.

Discussion

The project was completed in accordance with the terms, conditions and stipulations of the contract, plans and specifications. Construction was completed at a total cost of \$97,583.48, resulting in an underrun of \$3,492.02.

Alternatives

It appears that the Council has the following alternatives concerning the issue at hand. The Council may:
