#### **Background**

The owners of Prairie Commons Subdivision have requested that the City vacate the Prairie Commons Subdivision to aid the replatting and approval of Prairie Commons Second Subdivision. Prairie Commons Subdivision, approved on August 23, 2016. This is the site of the new hospital and associated development at the southwest corner of U.S. Highway 281 and Husker Highway.

#### **Discussion**

This request was made to facilitate the replatting of this property into Prairie Commons Second Subdivision. Vacating and replatting these lots and easements resolve issues with public utilities and utility services as they were installed. It will not create any conflicts with installed utilities or approved streets.

New easements and right of way will be dedicated for streets and utilities with the approval of Prairie Commons Second Subdivision on the agenda at this meeting.

#### **Alternatives**
