#### **Background**

Nebraska State Law requires that acquisition of property must be approved by City Council. The Utilities Department needs to acquire utility easement relative to the property of Lawrence J. and Sarah Lynn Levering, located through a part of Lot Three (3), Pulte Second Subdivision, Hall County, Nebraska (3551 N. Highway 281), in order to have access to install, upgrade, maintain, and repair power appurtenances, including lines and transformers.

#### **Discussion**

Grones Outdoor Power is upgrading an existing facility located at 3551 N. Highway 281. As part of the work, the Utilities Department needs to re-route the existing three-phase overhead power line and install a pad-mounted transformer to provide service to the upgraded building. The proposed easement will allow the Utilities Department to install, access, operate and maintain the electrical infrastructure at this location.

#### **Alternatives**

It appears that the Council has the following alternatives concerning the issue at hand. The Council may:

- 2. Refer the issue to a Committee
- 3. Postpone the issue to future date
- 4. Take no action on the issue
