Background

Water Main Project 2021-W-2 has been completed by The Diamond Engineering Company of Grand Island, Nebraska. The water main project installed approximately 717 linear feet of 8” diameter ductile iron water main by trenchless construction within Newcastle Road, east of Windsor Road to Coventry Lane. The project replaced the existing 6” water main which was subjected to multiple breaks over its lifetime.

Discussion

The project has been completed in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract documents and plans. The final contract amount for the work was \$150,877.40.

It appears that the Council has the following alternatives concerning the issue at hand. The Council may:

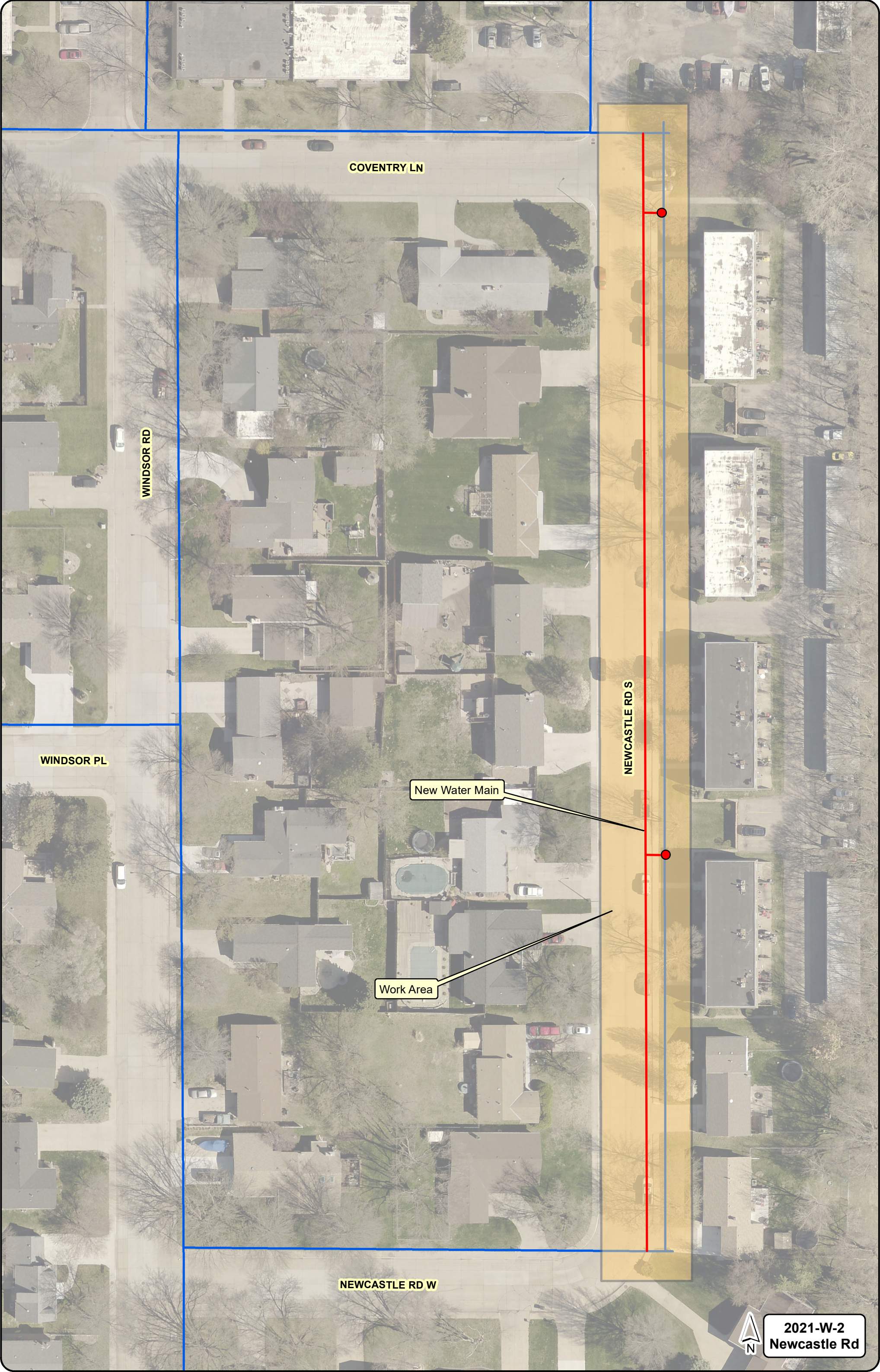
1. Move to approve


