Background

The Grand Island Police Department has been awarded a 2021 Victim of Crime Act (VOCA) Grant for \$128,394.00 from the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice. Any match for this program year is waived due to Covid. The program period for this grant is from 7-1-21 through 6-30-22.

Discussion

A requirement for acceptance of the grant is that the grant award and special conditions document be signed by the Mayor. The Grand Island Police Department is requesting that the listed grant award be signed for the acceptance of the award.
