

PATRON VISITS - PREVIOUS THREE MONTHS









*September 2021 – Cataloging backlog from July/August cataloging freeze was completed, resulting in a larger number of filled holds.

In-House use are barcoded materials patrons use in the library without checking out the items (such as browsing magazines) that are placed on designated shelves for statistical counting.
