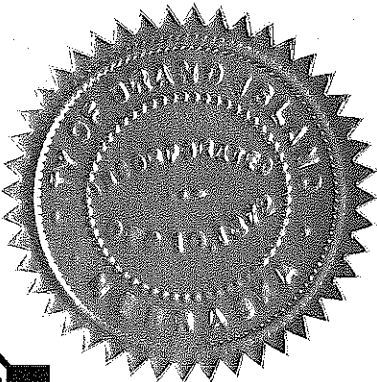




in the City of Grand Island, and encourage all citizens to support this event.
