Public Hearing on Acquisition of Right of Way Located on Willow Street at the Intersection with Seedling Mile Road

Right-of-Way was acquired for a cul-de-sac at the north end of Willow Drive at the intersection with Seedling Mile Road when the Livengood Subdivision was filed. This cul-de-sac was planned to accommodate the closing of the historical section of Seedling Mile Road east of Willow Drive. The cul-de-sac on the Livengood Subdivision plat was centered on Willow Drive necessitating considerable relocation work for the utility pole north and east of the intersection. The acquisition of this Right-of-Way will allow the cul-de-sac to be redesigned and shifted to the east, eliminating the need for the utility relocation work. LANNCO, L.L.C. has agreed to deed 0.0587 acres to the City of Grand Island. The action item is on the Consent Agenda. It is appropriate at this time to solicit public comment.
