Public Hearing on Request of James McCaslin of CXT/LB Foster for a Conditional Use Permit to Allow for the Continued use of Temporary Buildings Located at 710 E. US Hwy. #30

James McCaslin representing CXT/LB Foster Company, has submitted an application with the City Clerk's Office for a Conditional Use Permit to allow the continued use of two temporary structures located at 710 E. Hwy #30. The two buildings are used as office and employee break facilities, they have been on site and approved by council since June of 1998 and are expected to be needed for the life of CXT's initial contract with the Union Pacific. This contract is expected to expire on September 30,2003. This request has been reviewed by the Building, Legal, Utilities, Planning and Public Works Departments. It is appropriate at this time to solicit public comment. The action item is contained under the Consent Agenda.
