### **#8804 - Consideration of Amendment to Chapter 10 of the Grand Island City Code Relative to Mausoleums**

*Currently City Code Chapter 10-16 reads as follows. No mausoleum shall be constructed in the City Cemetery until an application therefore has been presented and approved by the City Council. Such application shall be accompanied by detailed plans and specifications of the proposed mausoleum and shall designate the kind of natural stone to be used in the construction thereof.*

*It is the recommendation of the Parks and Recreation Department that the required approval of the City Council be changed to read the approval of the Parks and Recreation Director with the concurrence of the Building Department.*

ORDINANCE NO. 8804

An ordinance to amend Chapter 10 of the Grand Island City Code; to amend Section 10-16 pertaining to mausoleums; to repeal Section 10-16 as now existing, and any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith; and to provide for publication and the effective date of this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND ISLAND, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. Section 10-16 of the Grand Island City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**§10-16. Mausoleums**

No mausoleum shall be constructed in the city cemetery until an application therefor has first been presented to and approved by the Parks and Recreation Director with the concurrence of the building department director of the structural integrity of such mausoleum city council. Such application shall be accompanied by detailed plans and specifications of the proposed mausoleum and shall designate the kind of natural stone to be used in the construction thereof. Any mausoleum hereafter erected shall be constructed above the ground and shall be properly ventilated.

SECTION 2. Section 10-16 as now existing, and any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and hereby are, repealed.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication, within fifteen days in one issue of the Grand Island Independent as provided by law.
