#2003-392 - Approving Certificate of Final Completion for Suck's Lake Restoration/Cottonwood Lake Dredging Project

The Park and Recreation Department in conjunction with the Public Works Department has recommended that the Certificate of Final Completion be issued for the Sucks Lake Restoration/Cottonwood Lake Dredging Project. The contract was awarded to General Excavating, of Lincoln Nebraska on March 24, 2003. The work commenced in April of 2003 and was completed in December, 2003. The performance of the contract was supervised by the Parks and Recreation and Public Works Departments and a Certificate of Final Completion has been issued by the Park and Recreation Director in conjunction with the Public Works Director, subject to City Council approval.
