I represent Luis Gutierrez of Grand Island. This is a claim under the Political Subdivision Tort Claims Act, §§ 13-901, et seq., Neb. Rev. Stat.

This claim arose on or about January 6, 2003, when Mr. Gutierrez was arrested by the Grand Island Police Department. Mr. Gutierrez's vehicle was not secured by the Police and it was taken without authorization and when it was located the next day, it had sustained major damage. Mr. Gutierrez is making demand for \$3,000.00 for damages to his vehicle and \$296.24 for towing charges.

We have heretofore been in contact with the City Attorney and the carrier for the City, however, to avoid any question that a claim had been submitted, I felt I should follow up with a formal claim letter.
