Background

This request is to allow for the construction of a telecommunication tower and associated facilities at the above referenced location. The zoning regulations provide for the placement of these types of towers and facilities in all zones with the approval of the City Council in the form of a conditional use permit.

The intent of the tower and telecommunication facilities and antenna regulations is to protect residential areas and land uses from the potential adverse impact of the installation of towers and antennas through careful design, sitting, and camouflaging, to promote and encourage shared use/collocation of towers, and to ensure that towers and antennas are compatible with the surrounding land uses.

Discussion

The City code specifies eight items to be submitted with the application for a tower development permit, five of those items have been submitted and appear in order, the remaining three items need to be submitted to complete this request. The first is an affidavit attesting to the fact that unsuccessful attempts have been made to collocate with any towers within one mile of the proposed site. A current tower exists east of Gunbarrel and north of Bismark, it appears that this tower is not adequate structurally to support an additional antenna but no documentation has been received. The second item is evidence from an engineer that the proposed tower will meet building code standards, this evidence will be needed before a building permit will be issued and delaying submission until that time is reasonable. The third item is a color simulation showing the proposed tower at the site.

The proposed location does not appear to create any negative impact on the surrounding properties and approval conditioned upon the three remaining items being submitted appears reasonable.

Alternatives

It appears that the Council has the following alternatives concerning the issue at hand. The Council may:

- 1. Approve the request.
- 2. Disapprove or /Deny the request.
- 3. Modify the request to meet the wishes of the Council
- 4. Table the issue

Recommendation

City Administration recommends that the Council approve the request for a conditional use permit pending the submission of the three remaining items prior to construction permits.

Sample Motion

Move to approve the request for a conditional use permit for the construction of a telecommunication tower at 233 S. Gunbarrel Road.
