Background

This is a request to allow for the construction of an 80 foot telecommunication tower at 636 S. Shady Bend Road for the broadcast of a low power FM station. The Grand Island Zoning Code requires all telecommunication tower receive the approval of City Council in the form of a conditional use permit prior to construction.

The intent of the tower and telecommunication facilities and antenna regulations are to protect residential areas and land uses from the potential adverse impact of the installation of towers and antennas through careful design, sitting, and camouflaging, to promote and encourage shared use/collocation of towers, and to ensure that towers and antennas are compatible with the surrounding land uses.

Discussion

The City code specifies eight items to be submitted with the application for a tower development permit, those items have been submitted and appear to be in order. There are not other towers within a one mile radius of this request and as such the proposal appears to be a reasonable request.

Alternatives

It appears that the Council has the following alternatives concerning the issue at hand. The Council may:

1. Approve the conditional use permit.

- 2. Disapprove or /Deny the conditional use permit.
- 3. Modify the conditional use to meet the wishes of the Council
- 4. Table the issue

Recommendation

City Administration recommends that the Council approve the request for a conditional use permit to construct a telecommunication tower.
