Background

Nebraska State Law requires that acquisition of property must be approved by City Council. The Utilities Department needs to acquire an easement relative to the property of Allen Webb Road, LLC, located through a part of Lot Eleven (11) Meadowlark West Fourth Subdivision (along the east side of 1002 N. Webb Road, east of Home Depot), in the City of Grand Island, Hall County, in order to have access to install, upgrade, maintain, and repair all utilities, but specifically water mains.

Discussion

This easement will be used to place a water main on the west side of Webb Road to provide water service to the three lots (10, 11, & 13) of Meadowlark Fourth Subdivision.

Alternatives

It appears that the Council has the following alternatives concerning the issue at hand. The Council may:
