in 2006, twenty-six children in Grand Island, Hall County were adopted from foster care; and

by December 2007, twenty-four children in Grand Island, Hall County will finalize adoption from foster care; and

children from foster care in Grand Island, Hall County are

awaiting loving, permanent families; and

WHEREAS,

every child deserves a place to call home.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Margaret Hornady, Mayor of the City of Grand Island, Nebraska, do hereby proclaim the month of November, 2007 as
