Background

Gary Smith Construction Company, Inc. of Grand Island was awarded a \$718,376.68 contract on May 27, 2008. The contract was for asphalt resurfacing in 12 areas of the City of Grand Island. Work commenced on July 17, 2008 and was completed on August 13, 2008.

Discussion

The project was completed in accordance with the terms, conditions, and stipulations of the contract, plans, and specifications. It was completed at a total cost of \$747,592.92, for an overrun total of \$29,216.24. The overrun on this project was due to the depth of milling required on 3rd Street. The estimate was figured with a 2" milling, however in order to remove all existing asphalt, to the bricks underneath, a 4" milling was necessary.

The additional funds are available in Account No. 10033503-85547.
