## **Background**

On April 28, 2010 the Engineering Division of the Public Works Department advertised for bids for the 2010 Asphalt Resurfacing Project Number 2010-AC-1. There were 4 potential bidders for the project. This year's work involves asphalt resurfacing on a number of important city streets, the widening of Stolley Park Road east of Locust Street past the entrance to the State Fair to a 3-lane roadway and the widening of Stolley Park Road at Stuhr Road to accommodate 2 lanes for eastbound traffic and one for westbound traffic.

Bid section 2A was set up for an alternate bid using a recycled asphalt mix. The recycled asphalt mix is considered equal to an asphalt mix.

The following is a list of the streets included in the 2010-AC-1 project:

**Section #1.** Shady Bend Road from south of Gregory Avenue to south of US Hwy 30.

**Section #2.** Eddy Street from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to the Five Points intersection  
(Including all of the Five Points intersection).

**Section #3.** Broadwell Avenue from the Five Points intersection to College Street.

**Section #4.** 1<sup>st</sup> Street (Eastbound US Highway 30) from Sycamore Street to Plum Street.

**Section #5.** Locust Street from Fonner Park Road to Charles Street.

**Section #6.** Walnut Street from Division Street to 1<sup>st</sup> Street.

**Section #7.** Old NE Highway 2 from O’Flannagan Street to Broadwell Avenue

**Section #8.** Webb Road from Old NE Highway 2 to US Highway 281.

**Section #9.** Stolley Park Road from south Locust Street to a ½ mile east.

**Section #10.** Stolley Park Road starting 400’ west of Stuhr Road.

## **Discussion**

Two (2) bids were received and opened on May 5, 2010. The bids were submitted in compliance with the contract, plans, and specifications. A summary of the bids is shown below.
