#### **Background**

This request is for Council approval to allow for the placement of a temporary office trailer at 3304 S. Engleman Road. The office trailer will facilitate operations for a groundwater remediation project. The Environmental Protection Agency has contracted with Prudent Technologies to inject chemicals into the ground water at this site in an effort to clean up past contamination that affect the ground water in southern Grand Island and the surrounding area.

# **Discussion**

The City code allows for temporary buildings and uses if approved by the City Council in the form of a Conditional use permit. This request is to allow for the placement of a temporary trailer to aid in the operation of equipment to facilitate cleanup efforts at the site. The site location is such that it does not appear the temporary trailer will have any negative impact on the neighboring properties during the operation.

### **Alternatives**

It appears that the Council has the following alternatives concerning the issue at hand. The Council may:

1. Approve the request for a conditional use permit finding that the proposed use is a listed conditional use in the zoning code and that it will not be detrimental to public health, safety, and general welfare of the community.

- 2. Disapprove or Deny the conditional use permit, finding that the proposal does not conform to the purpose of the zoning regulations.
- 3. Modify the conditional use to meet the wishes of the Council.
- 4. Refer the matter to a special committee for a determination of a finding of fact.
- 5. Table the issue.

#### **Recommendation**

City Staff recommends that the Council approve the request for a conditional use permit to place a temporary office trailer at the site for a two year period, finding that the request does promote the health, safety, and general welfare of the community, protects property against blight and depreciation, and is generally harmonious with the surrounding neighborhood.

#### **Sample Motion**

Move to approve the requested conditional use permit as specified in the staff recommendation published in the Council packet and presented at the City Council meeting and finding that the application will conform with the purpose of the zoning regulations.
