Background

City Council approved Resolution 736 on December 10, 1973 which prohibits parking on both sides of Fonner Park Road from South Locust Street to Pleasant View Drive.

Discussion

It has been determined that the no parking restriction on Fonner Park Road from South Locust Street to Pleasant View Drive is not warranted on a permanent basis. It has not been enforced in the past 30+ years and there have not been any safety issues that have arisen with parking along this stretch.

Alternatives

It appears that the Council has the following alternatives concerning the issue at hand. The Council may:

1. Move to approve
2. Refer the issue to a Committee
3. Postpone the issue to future date
4. Take no action on the issue
