## **Background**

Council action is required to designate No Parking on any public street.

At the October 25, 2011 Council Meeting a request from St. Steven's Episcopal Church to remove parking between Walnut Street and Cedar Street, on the north side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street was presented.

City Council referred this item to the November 8, 2011 meeting.

## **Discussion**

Upon further evaluation of this request The Engineering Division of the Public Works Department will need to review the request with the Nebraska Department of Roads, as 2<sup>nd</sup> Street is a State highway. This item will be presented to City Council at a later date once an agreeable solution is reached with all parties.
