Discussion Concerning Cooperative Service Field Agreement with the Wildlife Services for Wildlife Damage Control

This item was pulled from the June 10, 2003 City Council Agenda so further discussion could take place. The USDA Wildlife Service has proposed a cooperative field agreement with the City of Grand Island to help control the skunk population that has been spreading rabies. The cost of this agreement is \$2,500. The agreement is scheduled to take effect as of June 2, 2003 if approved by the City. The agreement would remain in effect until the funds are depleted by the services rendered by the Wildlife Services. The Wildlife Service estimates that the agreement should cover services for the months of June, July and August. Ronald Fryda representing the US Department of Ag Wildlife Services will be present for the meeting.
