




City of Grand Island New Application Process




Liquor Control Commission New Application Process



City of Grand Island Change of Location, Reconstruction, Additions, Deletions




Example 2.1 Liquor Control Commission Change of Location, Reconstruction, Additions, Deletions





Liquor Control Commission Renewal Long Form






City of Grand Island/Liquor Control Commission Special Designated License (SDL)

The application for a Special Designated Liquor license is submitted for review at least twenty one days prior to the event date

An applicant must obtain an SDL through a local Liquor License Dealer

or

An applicant must have a Catering License



-License valid on effecive date

An application must have a favorable police report issued relating to the type and level of security to be provided to insure that the liquor laws, and in particular the liquor laws relating to the sale to and consumption by minors, will be complied.

	Retail: Corporation **
•	 Any officer, manager, or director of the corporation or any stockholder owning more than 25% of the stock must qualify to above individual restrictions. The manager and spouse of the corporation must be a resident of Nebraska and qualify to above individual restrictions. Corporation must be registered with the Secretary of State. Corporation owned by a corporation, the owning corporation must register with the Secretary of State.
