- A. Clean and prepare surface for color coating.
- B. Fill all cracks with patch binder.
- C. Birdbaths will be filled with tennis court patch binder.
- D. Note: Although filler material will be applied to the most severe birdbaths there is no guarantee expressed or implied that all low areas can totally be eliminated.
- E. Install one coat of acrylic resurface.
- F. Install two coats of Deco Color System.
- G. Stripe courts to USTA standards.
- H. A one year warranty on workmanship and material.
