

On 07/29/2015 at approximately 0915 hours I contacted Marlin Duncan the owner of Valley Bowl Fun Center in reference to the addition to their liquor license. Marlin showed me the addition which is a fenced in area on the north side of the business that surrounds a miniature golf course and a patio area. Marlin told me that when the miniature golf is open it can be accessed through a gate in the fence or through a door on the north side of the bowling alley. Marlin explained there will always be an attendant who is at least 21 years of age stationed inside the fence to monitor the activities of the outdoor area. Marlin added that when the miniature golf is closed bowling alley patrons can go outside to the patio area to smoke or just sit but will have to access the area through the building, the gate will be secured. Marlin told me that anyone wanting to consume alcohol will have to go to the bar to obtain it. Marlin said they will not provide any wait staff for the outdoor area. Marlin told me that they will monitor the outdoor activity just as they do the indoor activity.

There have been no alcohol related incidents reported to the police department during the time of this license.

Action:

The Development Services Department is required by Article 1, Chapter 11 of the Scottsbluff Municipal Code to report specific information to the Mayor and City Council whenever a liquor license application hearing is held. In accordance with that directive the following information is offered:

- (1) The property is situated in a C-2 Neighborhood and Retail Commercial zoning district where the proposed use is permitted by right pursuant to the City's Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 25, of the City's Municipal Code of Ordinances.
- (2) The area surrounding the Valley Bowl Fun Center property provides adequate off-street parking for the center. Municipal Code 25-5-1(2) requires that a bowling alley must have six parking spaces per lane. Parking will comply with these requirements.
- (3) The business is situated at the northwest corner of the intersection of 17th Avenue and East 17th Street. Occupancy of the building as a bowling facility does not adversely affect the surrounding neighborhood, as there are no public or private institutions in close proximity to the subject property.
- (4) There are no churches, schools or other similar institutions within 500 feet of the subject property.
- (5) The existing population of Scottsbluff is approximately 15,039.
