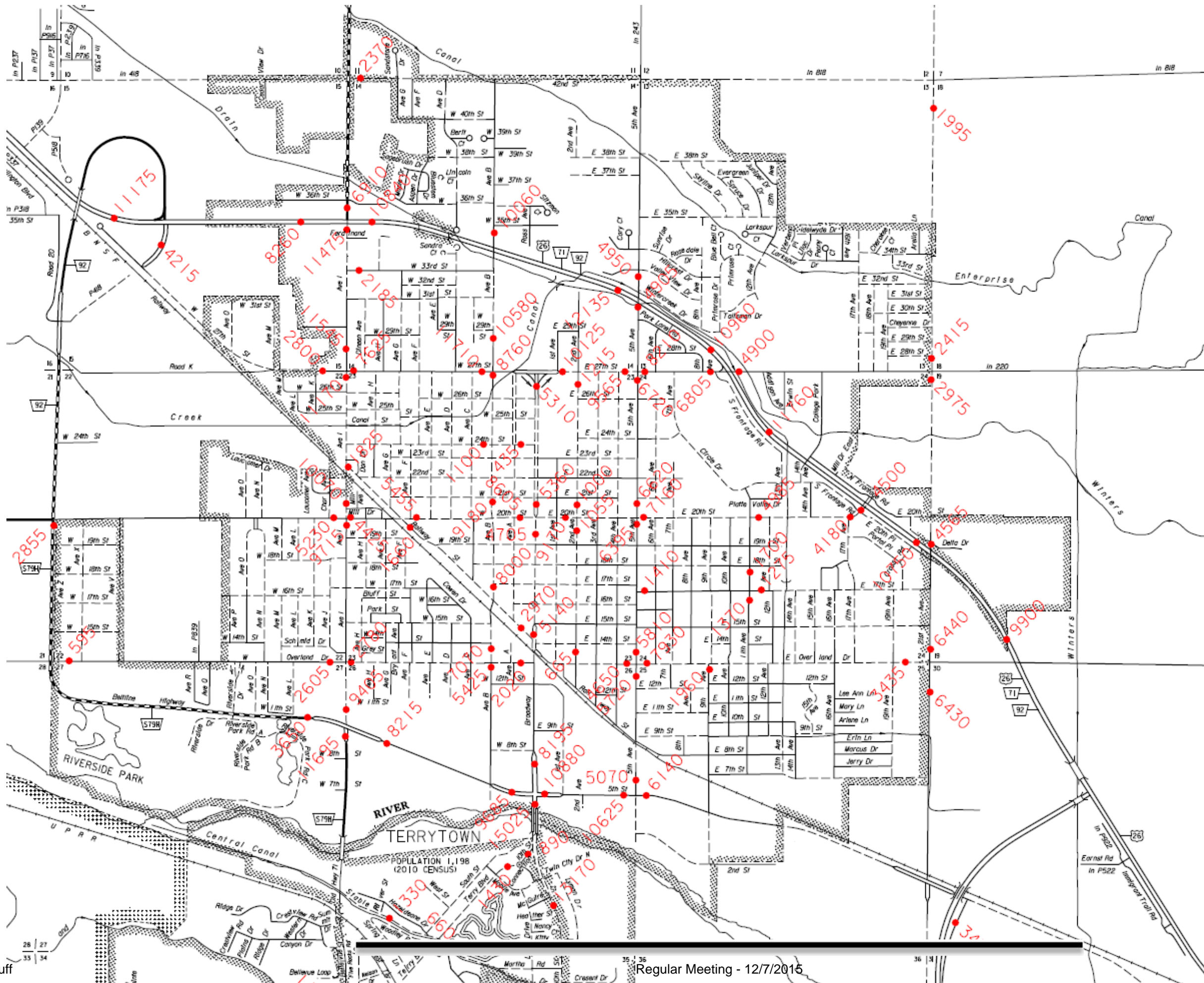

Subject: Street Projects

As requested I have listed a number of streets that are in need of an overlay or remove and replace. They are in no particular order but are listed below.

- 1) East Overland from 1st avenue east to 21st street
- 2) West Overland from Broadway west to Beltline Highway
- 3) Avenue B from west Overland north to Highway 26
- 4) 20th Street from Cleveland Field East to Highway 26
- 5) 42nd Street from Highway 71 (Avenue I) east to 5th Avenue
- 6) Frontage Road from 27th to 20th Street
- 7) West 27th from Avenue I west to City limits
- 8) Railway from Broadway to 20th Street
- 9) South Beltline Highway from Broadway east to the east city Limits
- 10) Avenue A from 27th street south to Railway

Again, These are in no preference order but a list of Streets that really need to have work done whether it be an overlay or remove and replace as I mentioned earlier. I hope this helps and If I can get you anymore information just let me know.

Rick and Nathan:

An additional ½cent on retail sales.

Approval of 70% of council(4).

Approval by voters at a primary or general election.

Not more than a year before ballot submission must have in place an Inter-local agreement with another political subdivision (county for 42nd as an example, CRA as another example). It must create a separate administrative entity which relates to a public infrastructure project.

Expires no longer than 10 years or bond expiration whichever is longer.

Ballot language: Shall the governing body of the City of SB impose a sales and use tax upon the same transactions within the City of SB on which the State of Ne is authorized to impose a tax? The question must also include a list of reductions or limitations for any other taxes, if any; a description of the infrastructure projects to be funded; the length of time imposed.
