THE MUNICIPAL CODE TO REVISE \$20-6-20 DEALING WITH THE REMOVAL OF SNOW FOLLOWING A SNOWFALL ON SIDEWALKS THAT ARE CONTIGUOUS TO LOTS AND PROPERTY, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PROVIDING AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSBLUFF, NEBRASKA FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM. OF OF COUNCIL AND CITY IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR SCOTTSBLUFF, NEBRASKA: Article 6 of the Scottsbluff Municipal Code is amended by repealing the existing language and substituting the following language: Chapter 20, Section 1.

## 20-6-20. Snow, ice, mud; removal; nuisance.

r permit snow, sleet, ice, mud, slush or other substance to accumulate or remain on the sidewalks t shall be unlawful for the occupant of any lot or the owner of any vacant lot within the City to suffer ontiguous to the lot, or to permit any hardened trodden snow, sleet, ice, mud, slush or other ubstance to remain upon such sidewalk. Such sidewalk shall be cleaned and cleared from such ubstances by noon (12:00 p.m.) the day following the end of any snowfall. Any snow, sleet, ice, and, slush or other substance which remains on a sidewalk contrary to the provisions of this section s declared to be a public nuisance."

Previously existing Sections 20-6-20 and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in ny rights, liabilities, duties or causes of action, either criminal or civil, existing or actions pending t the time when this Ordinances becomes effective. ection 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and approval and publication shall e in pamphlet form.
