 - i) within the general vicinity of Avenue A, Broadway, and 1st Avenue, between 23rd Street on the north and 18th Street on the south, in the central portion of the City of Scottsbluff is blighted and substandard.
 - c) Council to set a public hearing for May 17, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. to submit question of whether an area generally described as properties and tracts of land

- i) north of East 15th Street and south of East 17th Street, beginning at 21st Avenue on the east and running west for a distance of two blocks, in the southeastern portion of the City of Scottsbluff is blighted and substandard.
- d) Council to set a public hearing for May 17, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. to submit question of whether an area generally described as properties and tracts of land
 - i) within the general vicinity south of the Burlington Northern Santa Fe railroad right-of-way, east of 9th Avenue, west of 13th Avenue and north of and including South Beltline Highway East in the southeastern portion of the City of Scottsbluff is blighted and substandard.
- e) Council to set a public hearing for May 17, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.to submit question of whether an area generally described as properties and tracts of land
 - i) within the general vicinity between Avenues A and C and between West Overland Drive and West 18th Street, including a corridor extending westerly from Avenue B along the southern border of the BNSF railroad right-of-way and north of Cowen Drive, in the south-central portion of the City of Scottsbluff is blighted and substandard.
