





SUBLEASE

This Sublease is made effective on April 1, 2021, between Lucky One, LLC ("Lucky One") and RSK Frontside, LLC ("RSK").

Recitals:

- a. Lucky One is the "Tenant" under a Lease Agreement with the County of Scotts Bluff, Nebraska (the "Landlord") which was effective on October 1, 2012, and which has been extended to December 31, 2023 (the "Lease"). A copy of the Lease (including the most recent Lease Extension Agreement is attached and made a part of this Sublease by reference.
- b. RSK has entered into an agreement to purchase certain assets of Lucky One and Frontside, LLC pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement dated December 23, 2019 as amended effective April 1, 2021 (the "Purchase Agreement"). Pursuant to the Purchase Agreement, the parties have agreed to enter into this Sublease.
- c. Lucky One leases the Premises (as defined in the Lease) to Sublessee according to the terms and conditions of this Sublease.

Agreement:

1. Term:

This Sublease shall be effective as of April 1, 2021 (the "Effective Date") and shall continue until December 31, 2023 (the "Term").

2. Rent:

RSK shall pay to Lucky One "Rent" in the same amount and at the same times as provided for in the Lease. RSK shall have the right to pay the Rent directly to the Landlord.

3. Rights and Obligations:

RSK shall have all rights of Lucky One under the Lease, and shall be responsible for all obligations of Lucky One under the Lease.

4. Insurance:

RSK shall carry insurance as required of the Tenant under the Lease. RSK agrees to indemnity and hold Lucky One harmless for any damage that may be caused to Lucky One by RSK, its agents or employees.

5. Lease in Effect:

Lucky One represents and warrants that the Lease is in effect and shall remain in effect for the Term. At the end of the Term, and as long as RSK is not in default under this Sublease. Lucky One agrees that it will not engage in activities to renew the Lease, unless requested by RSK. The purpose of this provision is for RSK to have the right to negotiate with the Landlord for a new lease in RSK's name.

6. Termination:

- a. Lucky One shall have the right to terminate this Sublease upon a default by RSK which shall occur upon the happening of any of the following:

 - (3) The failure of RSK to correct any other default in this Sublease within 30 days after written notice by Lucky One.

Upon a default, Lucky One may elect to reenter the Real Estate and RSK shall peaceably surrender the Real Estate to Lucky One. In addition, Lucky One shall have all legal remedies available to it, including the right to accelerate all rentals due or to become due under this Sublease, to recover rentals as they become due, or to relet the Real Estate or any parts of the Real Estate on terms as Lucky One in its sole judgment deems advisable. LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS LEASE AGREEMENT hereinafter "AGREEMENT", made and entered into by and between SCOTTS BLUFF COUNTY, hereinafter "LANDLORD", whether one or more, and LUCKY ONE, LLC, hereinafter "TENANT", whether one or more; WITNESSETH

1. DESCRIPTION OF REAL ESTATE.

LANDLORD leases to TENANT the following described real estate, to-wit: 1001 Avenue I, Scottsbluff, Nebraska. The legal description of the Premises and Premises is as follows:

Lot Three (3), Block One (1), County Addition Replat, Situated in the Northwest Quarter of Section 26, Township 22 North, Range 55 West of the 6th P.M., Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska.

2. TERMS OF AGREEMENT.

This AGREEMENT shall commence on October 1, 2012 and end on December 31, 2013. (Second Term).

Following the Second Term the TENANT shall have the option to renew this Lease for an additional 5-year term under the same terms and conditions. In the event that TENANT desires to exercise its option, notice shall be given to the LANDLORD at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the Initial Term (the "Extended Term"). Provided, that during the Extended Term, either party may give the other party 60 days written notice to terminate the Lease.

3. PAYMENT OF RENT.

The rent for this AGREEMENT shall be payable as follows:

- A. The sum of \$1,000.00 on the tenth (10th) day of January, 2013.
- B. The sum of \$1,000.00 on the tenth (10th) day of each and every month thereafter for the term of this Lease Agreement and any extensions thereof.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF TENANT.

TENANT agrees to:

- A. Pay each installment of rent as the same becomes due.
- B. Keep said premises continually in a neat, clean and respectable condition. TENANT agrees to provide all janitorial services for the premises on a daily basis.
 - C. Permit LANDLORD or his agents at all reasonable times to enter into or

onto the premises and to examine the condition thereof and to make necessary major repairs.

- D. Yield up the premises and all additions thereto at the termination of this Lease Agreement in good and tenantable repair, reasonable use and wear and damage by fire or other unavoidable casualties excepted.
- E. The premises shall be used for the purpose of operating a tavern and restaurant and for related activities. TENANT shall have the exclusive right to sell and distribute all food and beverage items in the Premises, including all snack items and coffee.
- F. TENANT further agrees to comply with all federal, state, and municipal laws, rules, and regulations in the operation of the business.
- G. TENANT shall at TENANT's own expense obtain insurance for TENANT's improvements, alterations, fixtures, and contents, which provides for waiver of subrogation against LANDLORD's insurer. TENANT shall also carry a public liability insurance policy providing limits of \$500,000 naming LANDLORD as an additional insured and TENANT agrees to indemnify and hold LANDLORD harmless for any damage that may be caused to LANDLORD by TENANT, its agents or employees. If TENANT fails to obtain the required insurance and to pay the premiums charged, or to properly maintain and keep in force the insurance, LANDLORD shall have the right, at its sole option, to procure the insurance and pay the premiums charged. These amounts shall be deemed additional rent and shall be due and payable with the next installment of rent due from TENANT.
- H. This Lease Agreement is subject to TENANT's being able to obtain a Class C Liquor License. In the event that TENANT is unable to obtain this liquor license, after a good-faith attempt to do so, this Lease Agreement shall be null and void. Upon execution of this Agreement, TENANT represents that it will make an application to obtain a Class C Liquor License from the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES OF LANDLORD.

LANDLORD agrees to:

- A. Peacefully allow TENANT to hold and enjoy the premises during the term of this Lease Agreement and any extensions thereof, without any interruption by LANDLORD or any person rightfully claiming under him or his agents. LANDLORD represents to TENANT that the premises are capable of being used for the purposes intended and that the electrical, water, sewer, gas, heating, cooling, and ventilation systems are capable of accommodating TENANT'S operation.
- B. Make all necessary repairs to the premises located on the premises unless said repairs are occasioned by TENANT'S negligence or lack of care.
 - C. Assume responsibility for all maintenance and repairs, to maintain the

property at all times. Maintenance shall include the structure and roof of the premises, exterior sidewalk and paving, and the electrical, plumbing, heating and cooling systems. LANDLORD shall be responsible for all snow removal required for the parking areas adjoining the premises.

- D. LANDLORD shall carry the property and casualty insurance for the Premises. LANDLORD shall pay the premiums for this insurance.
- E. All utilities for the premises, including but not limited to water, sewer, sanitation, gas, electric, cable television, and any other utilities used by the TENANT, shall be paid by the LANDLORD.

6. NON-PAYMENT OF RENT.

If the rent reserved or any part thereof shall be unpaid for thirty (30) days after becoming due, whether formally demanded or not, or any covenant on the part of TENANT shall not be performed, or if TENANT shall become bankrupt, or abandon the property, then it shall be lawful for LANDLORD to re-enter at any time thereafter on the premises and thereupon this LEASE shall terminate, but without prejudice to the right of LANDLORD with respect to any privileges of TENANT's covenants herein contained.

7. DAMAGE TO PROPERTY.

In case the premises or a portion of the premises herein leased, or any part thereof, shall be damaged by fire or other unavoidable casualty, not due to the negligence of
TENANT, so that the same should be rendered unfit for use and occupancy, then the rent hereby reserved or a just and proportionate share thereof shall be evaded until the premises have
been duly repaired and restored by LANDLORD, or in the case that the premises shall be substantially destroyed, then at the election of LANDLORD the estate hereby created thereupon
shall be terminated.

8. INCLUSIONS.

Expressly included in this AGREEMENT shall be the right of use of common bathrooms, which shall be maintained by LANDLORD, along with the right of use of common parking lot and right of ingress and egress for all employees and business invitees of TENANT. TENANT shall further have the right to install such signs on said premises, at the TENANT'S own cost, as the TENANT determines is necessary.

LANDLORD may, at its discretion, make performance evaluations from time to time to determine the TENANT's capability to continue the operation of its business under the terms and conditions set forth herein. In the event these performance evaluations reveal deficiencies then the LANDLORD shall give a written report to TENANT outlining said deficiencies and providing a reasonable timeframe for correction not to exceed 30 days unless otherwise agreed upon in writing by parties.

Upon a default, LANDLORD may elect to re-enter the premises and TENANT shall peaceably surrender the premises to LANDLORD. In addition, LANDLORD shall have all legal remedies available to it, including but not limited to the right to accelerate all rentals due or to become due under this Lease Agreement, to recover rentals as they become due, or to re-let the premises or any parts of the premises on terms as LANDLORD in its sole judgment deems advisable. NO re-entry or taking possession of the premises by LANDLORD shall be construed as an election to terminate this Lease Agreement unless a written notice of that intention is given to TENANT.

10. TERMINATION BY TENANT.

TENANT shall have the right to terminate this Lease upon a default by LANDLORD which shall occur upon the happening of any of the following:

- a. LANDLORD's failure to contract the Keno operation or to operate a Keno lottery, or other form of legalized gambling, in the premises.
- b. The failure of LANDLORD to correct any other default in this Lease within 30

days after written notice by TENANT.

AUTHORITY: The Scottsbluff Police Department reports specific information to the City Council whenever a liquor license application is presented. The information furnished by the Police Department conforms to Chapter 53, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska 1943, and Section 53-132, which outlines the factors which the Commission may consider in granting a liquor license.

COMMENTARY

53-132: Section 2

(A) The applicant is fit, willing and able to properly provide the service proposed within the city where the premises described in the application are located:

The Scottsbluff Police Department conducted a background investigation on Sheryl Keller the owner of "Frontside" to determine her fitness to have and manage a liquor license. Sheryl reported a conviction for Driving Under Suspension in 1978, and Driving Under the Influence in 1991 or 1992, in Scotts Bluff County. The background investigation revealed no other convictions.

On Thursday, June 24, 2021 at 4:00 PM Sheryl appeared before the City of Scottsbluff Liquor License Investigatory Board. Sheryl explained to the board that she has owned the Log Cabin in Gering for 38 years, had a liquor license during that time, and has never had any type of compliance failure.

The applicant can conform to all provisions, requirements, rules and regulations provided for in the Nebraska Liquor Control Act:

Any operator must adhere to the existing laws while doing business in the community and adhere to acceptable business practices.

Sheryl explained that she strongly encourages all of her employees to card anyone who looks less than 35 years of age, adding that employees have access to a born-on calendar to assist them in determining a customers age. Sheryl explained that the Frontside has several cameras, including one inside the office where the overstock is kept and another on the outside of the office pointed at the door. Sheryl told the board that any employee found to have sold alcohol to a minor would be terminated. Sheryl further explained that she runs a very stringent operation and will be the one that orders and inventories all of the alcohol.

The applicant appears to have the ability and willingness to conform to language within the Nebraska Liguor Control Act.

(B) The applicant has demonstrated that the type of management and control exercised over the licensed premises will be sufficient to ensure that the licensed business can conform to all provisions, requirements, rules and regulations provided for in the Nebraska Liquor Control Act:

Sheryl Keller appears to have a good plan regarding the sell of alcohol and appears determined to provide services while conforming to all rules and regulations.

The Frontside is in a location that has been a restaurant bar for the past several years.

The applicant appears committed to complying with all provisions, requirements, rules and regulations provided for in the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.

(C) The issuance of the license is or will be required by the present or future public convenience and necessity:

The establishment opens at 9 AM every day closing at 11 PM Sunday through Wednesday, 12 AM Thursday and 1 AM Friday and Saturday.

Oversight and accountability will be a priority for the applicants as it relates to the sale of alcoholic beverages.

SPECIFIC ISSUES COMMISSION MAY CONSIDER

(D) The existence of a citizen's protest made in accordance with Section 53-133:

There have been no known citizen protests of this business.

(E) The nature of the neighborhood or community of the location of the proposed licensed premises:

The business is located at 1001 Ave I Scottsbluff, NE. It is a restaurant/bar that will attract customers when opened. Its location is easily accessible and convenient for customers. I would not anticipate any issues regarding location.

(F) The existence or absence of other retail licenses or bottle club licenses with similar privilege within the neighborhood or community of the location or the proposed licensed premises.

There are two other businesses in the area with liquor licenses.

(G) The existing motor vehicle and pedestrian traffic flow in the vicinity of the proposed licensed premises:

Although no recent traffic studies have been completed regarding motor vehicle traffic of the general area, the traffic flow is not of concern at this time nor is pedestrian traffic.

(H) The adequacy of existing law enforcement:

The Scottsbluff Police Department is authorized 33 full time officers in the department and handled approximately 17,073 calls for service in 2020. The number of liquor licenses within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Police Department, regardless of the class, continues to be a concern to the Police Department and even routine monitoring of their business practices is

difficult. Compliance checks continue to remain a concern to those businesses that sell alcohol to minors. The Nebraska State Patrol has assumed liquor law enforcement duties and their wide jurisdiction generally precludes any particular focus in the city.

(I) Whether the type of business or activity proposed to be operated in conjunction with the proposed license is and will be consistent with the public interest:

The Police Department would reserve making any statement which would indicate that the sale of alcohol is consistent with the public interest.

Adequate staffing and training, as well as close supervision of patrons are important. Cooperation with the Police Department by management will help to eliminate or diminish potential problems with violations.

RSK Frontside, LLC. has applied for a new liquor license in the name of Sheryl Keller.

The Development Services Department is required by Article 1, Chapter 11 of the Scottsbluff Municipal Code to report specific information to the Mayor and City Council whenever a liquor license application hearing is held. In accordance with that directive the following information is offered:

- (1) The property at 1001 Ave. I is situated in a C-3 (Heavy Commercial) zoning district where a restaurant, bar, and or tavern is allowed by right pursuant to the City's Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 25, of the City's Municipal Code of Ordinances. Also, retail sales are allowed in a C-3 zone.
- (2) There appears to be adequate off street parking although the lot is not marked making it difficult to count actual spaces.
- (3) The use of this property is consistent with the surrounding neighborhood, which is generally commercial in nature. A C-3 (Commercial) zone abuts to the south, east, and north. C-2 (Commercial) abuts to the west.
- (4) There are no churches, schools, or other similar institutions within 300 feet of the subject property.
- (5) The existing population of Scottsbluff is approximately 15,039.

City of Scottsbluff Liquor License Holders Investigatory Board Regular Meeting June 24, 2021 - 4:00 p.m.

The City of Scottsbluff Liquor License Holders Investigatory Board met in a regular meeting on Thursday, June 24, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. in the Meeting Room of City Hall, 2525 Circle Drive, Scottsbluff. A notice of the meeting had been published on June 20, 2021 in the Star Herald, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the city. The notice stated the date, hour and place of the meeting, that the meeting would be open to the public. That anyone with a disability desiring reasonable accommodation to attend the meeting should contact the city clerk's office, and that an agenda of the meeting kept continuously current was available for public inspection at the office of the City Clerk in City Hall; provided, the committee could modify the agenda at the meeting if it determined that an emergency so required. A similar notice, together with a copy of the agenda, also had been delivered to each committee member.

- Roll Call The following Board Members were present: Dustin Rief, City Manager, Police Chief Kevin Spencer; Kim Wright, City Clerk, Libby Stobel, City Attorney, and Andrea Margheim, Flyover Brewery, Absent: Kelli Larson, Panhandle Prevention Coalition, Norman Coley, WNCC, Matt Huck, Scottsbluff Public Schools and Russ Knight, Chairman.
- 2. Open Meeting Act Acting Chairman Spencer welcomed everyone in attendance and informed those in attendance that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act is posted on the west wall for the public's review.
- 3. Call Meeting to Order The meeting was called to order and Wright recorded the proceedings.
- 4. There were no changes to the agenda.
- 5. Approve Minutes of the May 20, 2021 Regular Meeting Motion by Stobel, second by Margheim, to approve the May 20, 2021 Minutes, motion passed unanimously.
- 6. New Liquor License Application.
 - a. Class C Application, RSK Frontside, LLC d/b/a Frontside, 1001 Avenue I, Scottsbluff, NE 69361; Sheryl A. Keller, Manager.

Ms. Keller was present and gave a brief history explaining she has held a Liquor License at her other business, the Log Cabin in Gering, since 1990. She added she has never had a compliance failure; the policy is to check every ID and if they do not have an ID, they are not served.

Concerning Frontside, she explained the overstock is kept in a locked room that has a camera and there is also a camera pointed at the door. She does all the inventory and ordering. She also added they have a wonderful point of sale system that inventories liquor bottles to make sure there is not an over pouring of alcohol in a drink and also keeps a total of the stock they have to use. She explained she has inherited a wonderful crew that is experienced in this type of work. They have born on calendars in the business and if an employee would sell to a minor, they would be terminated, no exceptions.

Police Chief Spencer asked about training. Ms. Keller stated she does all the training of her employees. Mr. Spencer commented he would like everyone to take the TIPS training offered by Rob Jackson with the State Patrol or Lanette Richards with Monument Prevention Coalition. Ms. Keller stated she would try to set something up before the City Council meeting on July 6th.

At the end of discussion, Legal Counsel Stobel explained she would not be able to participate in any voting; she is declaring a conflict of interest due to having participated in and reviewing the application that was sent to the Liquor Control Commission. Because there was not a quorum of committee members remaining, a recommendation could not be made regarding the Class C Liquor License for Frontside, LLC d/b/a Frontside. Police Chief Spencer did state, however, he will forward a memo to be included in the City Council packet explaining everything that was discussed at the meeting.

7. New Manager Application

a. STL of Nebraska, Inc. d/b/a Target Store T - 0831, 1401 Frontage Road, Scottsbluff, NE - Naming Andrew R. Guenther as Manager.

Mr. Scott Marsh, Manager of Target Store T-0831 was present to answer questions on behalf of liquor license manager Andrew Guenther who resides in Omaha. Mr. Marsh started by explaining their system when they receive inventory. They have one person that checks in all the alcohol and all overstock is kept in a stockroom in the back that is under camera surveillance. Mr. Marsh also added, all alcohol that is purchased by guests has to be done up front with the checkers. The POS system they have in place stops the sale and a birthdate has to be put in to be able to continue. Mr. Marsh explained because of this, any person who purchases alcohol must present their ID at that time, as that is store policy. He also added the system will lock out an underage checker so they cannot make the sale.

He commented the store has not received a violation and he attributes that to setting clear expectations with employees when they are hired. If an employee would sell to a minor they would be terminated. He also mentioned the store has 58 cashiers. The employees are expected to take online training to become certified and all are certified at this time.

Committee Member Margheim moved, seconded by Police Chief Spencer to send a Postitive Recommendation naming Andrew R. Guenther as the Liquor License Manager of STL of Nebraska, Inc. d/b/a Target Store T-0831, 1401 Frontage Road, Scottsbluff, NE. Motion passed unanimously.

8. Liquor License Compliance Issue:

a. Board review and discussion of failed compliance check at Sam & Louie's Pizzeria.

Ms. Melissa Schnieder was present on behalf of Sam & Louie's Pizzeria to answer questions regarding their recent compliance check failure. Ms. Schneider explained the violation happened during one of their busiest shifts and she was in the restaurant when it occurred trying to fix a debit card machine problem. She reiterated that does not excuse the failure, but was trying to explain why it happened. She stated the employee did not check ID and was suspended because of her actions resulting in the violation. Ms. Schneider did explain, however, the server is a model employee who just got caught up in the moment. She did bring the employees certification to prove that she has gone through
