This applicant, Jessica D. Little Hoop, was investigated for suitability as the Chili's Liquor License manager. Jessica did not report any criminal history. I did find a "No Operator's License" conviction in March of 2016. I called Jessica to discuss this conviction. Jessica told me that she forgot to report it. I discovered nothing that would prohibit her from holding a manager's position under the license.

Thursday, December 16, 2021, Jessica appeared before the Liquor License Holders' Investigatory Board. Jessica explained Chili's rules and procedures as they relate to alcohol sales. Jessica explained that all employees have to complete Chili's alcohol training, adding that she additionally took the "ServSafe Alcohol Training." Jessica said that it is Chili's policy to ask anyone that appears to be under the age of 40 for identification. Jessica said that she is responsible for the beer and alcohol regarding ordering and inventory.

The Liquor License Holders Investigatory Board unanimously approved a positive recommendation to the Nebraska Liquor Commission.

City of Scottsbluff Liquor License Holders Investigatory Board Regular Meeting December 16, 2021 - 4:00 p.m.

The City of Scottsbluff Liquor License Holders Investigatory Board met in a regular meeting on Thursday, December 16, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. in the Meeting Room of City Hall, 2525 Circle Drive, Scottsbluff. A notice of the meeting had been published on December 12, 2021 in the Star Herald, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the city. The notice stated the date, hour and place of the meeting, that the meeting would be open to the public. That anyone with a disability desiring reasonable accommodation to attend the meeting should contact the city clerk's office, and that an agenda of the meeting kept continuously current was available for public inspection at the office of the city clerk in City Hall; provided, the committee could modify the agenda at the meeting if it determined that an emergency so required. A similar notice, together with a copy of the agenda, also had been delivered to each committee member.

- 1. Roll Call The following Board Members were present: Dustin Rief, City Manager, Police Chief Kevin Spencer; Kim Wright, City Clerk, Libby Stobel, City Attorney, and Andrea Margheim, Flyover Brewery, Absent: Kelli Larson, Panhandle Prevention Coalition, Norman Coley, WNCC, Matt Huck, Scottsbluff Public Schools and Russ Knight, Chairman.
- 2. Open Meeting Act Acting Chairman Spencer welcomed everyone in attendance and informed those in attendance that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act is posted on the west wall for the public's review.
- 3. Call Meeting to Order The meeting was called to order and Wright recorded the proceedings.
- 4. There were no changes to the agenda.
- 5. Approve Minutes of the November 4, 2021 Regular Meeting Motion by Rief, second by Stobel, to approve the November 4, 2021 Minutes, motion passed unanimously.
- 6. New Manager Application.
 - a. Jessica LittleHoop, manager applicant, with Chili's, LLC d/b/a Chili's Grill and Bar was present to answer questions.

Police Chief Spencer started discussion by asking what experience Ms. LittleHoop has in the alcohol industry. Ms. LittleHoop stated she has no other experience with alcohol and has been employed with Chili's since June 2021 serving as a Front End House Manager. Mr. Spencer then asked the measures staff takes to prevent underage drinking. Ms. LittleHoop explained they do regular ID checks if a customer looks under 40; she also shadows the servers to make sure they are adhering to policy. She commented they have a manual behind the bar that outlines company procedures and they have modules in place for employees to complete liquor safety and serving classes. These modules are required training when an employee is hired and also need to be renewed after a period of time.

As far as what would happen to an employee if they were to sell to a minor, Ms. LittleHoop explained they would be pulled from the floor and sent home. She

commented she does not have the authority to fire; the general manager would make that decision.

Legal Counsel Stobel asked who does the alcohol ordering for the business. Ms. LittleHoop answered she is the person who does the ordering and all refrigerated liquor is kept in a locked cooler and all overstock is kept in a locked closet, adding only the managers have the keys to open. She also stated there are security cameras throughout the business including where the alcohol is kept.

Committee Member Margheim suggested they keep staff informed of looking at birthdates and distinguishing the different licenses (vertical for minor) as tools to help. In addition they should look at employees being certified through different training opportunities.

City Manager Rief moved, seconded by Committee Member Margheim to send a positive recommendation to City Council naming Jessica D. LittleHoop as the Liquor License Manager of Chili's, LLC d/b/a Chili's Grill & Bar, 826 West 36th Street, Scottsbluff, NE. Motion passed unanimously.

- 7. Liquor License Compliance Violation review and discussion:
 - a. Big Bats

Jennifer, manager with Big Bats, was present and explained their violation. She informed the committee the employee that sold the alcohol has been terminated. They have also removed the default button from the POS system so the employee has to enter the birthdate of the person purchasing alcohol and a birthdate can only be used once, adding they have cameras throughout the business including over the register. They also have updated all the scanners and if an alcohol purchase is denied, they are required to log it. In addition, all employees are required to take the alcohol training and be certified, but it is a challenge with heavy turnover right now.

b. Flyover Brewery

Andrea Margheim came forward and explained their violation involved a seasoned bartender who looked at the license and authorized the sale anyway. The employee has since been terminated. Ms. Margheim added they have met with all staff and have required them to take the TIPS training again.

c. Route 26 Mart

Mr. Anthony Parra, manager, explained his violation happened on November 6th and the employee that authorized the sale has been terminated. He informed the committee all managers take responsible beverage training and they have a POS system that will deny sales to underage and expired licenses. In addition they have multiple signs at registers. He added, the employee looked at the ID, recognized the name and did not scan the license into the system. Because of this, they will be looking at having all employees take alcohol training, but added it is hard with turnover.

8. Other Business

a. There was no other business to discuss.

The meeting adjourned at 4:23 p.m. with a motion by Spencer and second by Margheim. Motion passed unanimously.
