National Safety Month June 2022

Whereas the rate of unintentional injuries and deaths in the United States remain at unacceptable levels;

Whereas addressing musculoskeletal disorders, educating on impairment, providing employers with tools to prevent injuries and mitigating falls remain critical to preventing injuries and deaths in the United States:

Whereas the cost of unintentional injuries to workers and their employers exceeds \$1,158.4 billion each year and causes great suffering among individuals and their families;

Whereas Nebraska residents and all Americans deserve to live in communities that promote safe and healthy living;

Whereas preventing unintentional injuries and deaths requires the cooperation of all levels of government, employers and the general public;

Whereas the National Safety Council, founded in 1913, was congressionally chartered in 1953 to lead this nation in injury prevention through safety and health information, education, training and advocacy in the United States;

Whereas the Nebraska Chapter of the National Safety Council and National Safety Council work to promote policies, practices and procedures leading to increased safety, protection and health in business and industry, in schools and colleges, on roads and highways, and in homes and communities;

Whereas the Nebraska Chapter of the National Safety Council and National Safety Council in 2022 will provide this nation with a month-long public education campaign;

Whereas the summer season is a time of increased rates of unintentional injuries and deaths, it is an appropriate time to focus attention on injury risks and preventions;
