

ASSET PURCHASE AGREEMENT

This Asset Purchase Agreement (the "Agreement" is made on September 2022 between Dermer's, LLC, a Nebraska Limited Liability Company (the "Seller") and Montez Liquor, LLC (the "Buyer").

1. Description:

On the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, the Seller agrees to sell to Buyer the furniture, fixtures, equipment, leasehold improvements and signage, listed on Exhibit "A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the "Equipment"), as well as the inventory of supplies and goods for sale listed on Exhibit "B" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the "Inventory"), and the Real Estate which is legally described as follows:

Lot A, Dermer Subdivision, a subdivision of Lot 3, Block 12, and the East Half of Lot 2, Block 12, Imperial Subdivision to the City of Scottsbluff, Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska (commonly known as 1311 East Overland, Scottsbluff 69361)

(the "Real Estate").

2. Purchase Price:

The Purchase Price shall be \$95,000 costs payable at Closing in cash or certified funds. The Purchase Price shall be divided as follows:

- a) \$39,345.00 for Equipment and Inventory;
- b) \$55,655.00 for the Real Estate.

3. Closing and Possession:

4. Taxes:

The Seller shall be responsible for and shall pay any personal property taxes and assessments levied against the Assets for all years prior to 2022 along with all special assessments levied on the Assets in full. Taxes for 2022 shall be prorated between Buyer and Seller as of the date of Closing based on the most recent assessment available. Taxes for the remainder of the year of Closing and all subsequent years shall be paid for by the Buyer. The Seller has not received any notice of any special assessments which affect the Assets and to the Seller's knowledge, no such assessments are pending or contemplated.

5. Inspection and Condition of Assets:

a) The Buyer has personally inspected the Assets and Real Estate and is entering into this Agreement based on that inspection and not on any representations or warranties, express or implied, made by the Seller, except as otherwise provided for in this Agreement. At Closing, the Buyer will accept the Assets in an "as-is" condition with all faults.

6. Risk of Loss:

The risk of loss of damage to the Assets or Real Estate shall remain with the Seller until the Closing. If, prior to Closing, any part of the Assets is damaged by fire or other casualty, and it not repaired to its prior condition, then the Buyer may rescind this agreement.

7. Contingencies:

The Closing of this transaction is contingent on following:

- a) Buyer obtaining a loan or loans to finance the Purchase Price. Buyer shall Make application for any such loans within seven days of signing this Agreement. Buyer shall be responsible for all costs associated with the loans. Buyer agrees to use Buyer's best efforts to obtain the loans. The Buyer may have the Real Estate appraised either before or during the lending approval process, if any. If the Real Estate fails to appraise for an amount equal to or greater than the Purchase Price, and such failure affects the Buyer's ability to obtain financing, the Seller shall have the unilateral option of (i) rescinding and terminating this Agreement; (ii) accepting the appraised value as determined during the lender approval process, or (iii) before deciding upon options (i) or (ii) above, hiring at her own cost an independent appraiser and submitting the appraised valuation to the Buyer and the Buyer's lender.
- b) Buyer obtaining a liquor license from the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission (the "Commission") covering the Real Estate, or a Temporary Operating Permit in order to operate under the Seller's existing license.

- c) Seller receiving permission from the Commission to transfer the inventory of alcoholic liquors and beverages to Buyer and Buyer receiving permission from the Commission to make such purchase.
- d) Prior to Closing, Seller furnishing to the Buyer a title insurance commitment binder showing that the Seller has merchantable title to the Real Estate. If it is impossible to perfect title or if defects exist which will require court action or an unreasonable expense or time to cure, the Seller shall have the option to terminate this Agreement in writing.

The closing may be extended for a reasonable time if such extension is necessary for the parties to satisfy the above contingencies. If the above contingencies are not met prior to Closing, and cannot be met on or before December 31, 2022, then either party may rescind this Agreement in writing. However, upon the agreement of both parties, the above contingencies may be waived and the parties may proceed to closing without one or more of the above contingencies being met

8. Employees:

Seller agrees that prior to closing, the employment of any and all employees employed by Seller for the Business shall terminate. Buyer is under no obligation to offer employment to any of Seller's employees. Buyer may offer employment to any of Seller's employees as Buyer may determine. Seller agrees not to interfere with Buyer's employment of such personnel and Seller agrees to release such personnel from any confidentiality obligation they may have to Seller to the extent necessary to allow them to use their full knowledge of the Business for Buyer's benefit.

9. Representation and Warranties:

The Buyer represents that this Agreement constitutes a legal, binding, and valid obligation of the Buyer, enforceable according to its terms and the performance of this Agreement by the Buyer will not violate any law, rule, regulation, contract, or agreement applicable to Buyer. The Seller represents that this Agreement constitutes a legal, binding, and valid obligation of the Seller, enforceable according to its terms and the performance of this Agreement by the Seller will not violate any law, rule, regulation, contract, or agreement applicable to Seller.

10. Expenses of Sale:

Parties shall equally divide the cost of preparation of this Agreement, the Warranty Deed, all costs and fees associated with a closing agent, as well as recording fees, documentary stamp tax, and title insurance coverage. Buyer shall pay for all costs related to obtaining Buyer financing.

11. Default:

Time is of the essence. If either party shall default in the performance of this Agreement, the other party shall have all legal remedies available to them.

12. General Provisions:

- a) This Agreement shall not be assignable by either party without the consent of the other party, except that the Buyer may assign this agreement to any corporation or limited liability company in which the Buyers constitute the sole shareholders or members.
- b) This Agreement is binding upon and inures to the benefit of the parties and their respective successors and permitted assigns; provided, however, no assignment of all or any portion of this Agreement shall relieve any party of its obligations under this Agreement.

Montez Liquor, 1323 10th Ave. Scottsbluff, Nebraska 69361

AUTHORITY: The Scottsbluff Police Department reports specific information to the City Council whenever a liquor license application is presented. The information furnished by the Police Department conforms to Chapter 53, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska 1943, and Section 53-132, which outlines the factors the Commission may consider in granting a liquor license.

COMMENTARY

53-132: Section 2

(A) The applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly provide the service proposed within the city where the premises described in the application are located:

I conducted a background check on Olga and Jose Montelongo to determine their fitness to hold a liquor license. Olga reported not having any criminal convictions. I did not find any. Jose reported having one speeding ticket in 2016 in Scottsbluff, NE. I did not find any information that would disqualify either Olga or Jose.

After consideration, I have concluded that the applicant is fit to hold a liquor license.

(B) The applicant can conform to all provisions, requirements, rules, and regulations provided for in the Nebraska Liquor Control Act:

Any operator must adhere to the existing laws while doing business in the community and adhere to acceptable business practices.

On Wednesday, February 1, 2022, Olga and Jose appeared before the Liquor License Holders Investigatory Board to discuss their application. Olga explained that they have a policy that requires employees to check all customers' identification to determine their age when making an alcohol purchase. Olga told the board they had purchased a scanner to help determine a customer's age and a flashlight that would help them determine if the ID was valid. Olga added that the store has security cameras that record, located inside and outside. Olga told the board that if an employee sold alcohol to a minor they would have to be retrained.

The applicant appears to be able and willing to conform to language within the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.

(C) The applicant has demonstrated that the type of management and control exercised over the licensed premises will be sufficient to ensure that the licensed business can conform to

1

all provisions, requirements, rules, and regulations provided for in the Nebraska Liquor Control Act:

Olga told the board that the alcohol would be stored in a cooler inside of the store. Olga said that her son, Jose Montelongo Jr. and herself will order and inventory the alcohol. Olga said that they currently employ five people all family, and that she requires them all to attend training.

After hearing Olga and Jose's plan, and after answering several questions the board voted unanimously to send a positive recommendation to the Nebraska Liquor Commission.

The applicant appears committed to complying with all provisions, requirements, rules, and regulations provided for in the Nebraska Liquor Control Act.

(D) The issuance of the license is or will be required by the present or future public convenience and necessity:

The business will be opened seven days a week, opening at 10:00 A. M. and closing at 10:00 P. M., maybe later on the weekends. Montez Liquor is in a location that has been a liquor store for many years, lastly Dermer's Liquor.

Oversight and accountability will be a priority for the applicant as it relates to the sale of alcoholic beverages.

SPECIFIC ISSUES COMMISSION MAY CONSIDER

(E) The existence of a citizen's protest made in accordance with Section 53-133:

There have been no known citizen protests of this business.

(F) The nature of the neighborhood or community of the location of the proposed licensed premises:

The business is located at 1323 10th Ave, Scottsbluff, NE. It will is a liquor store that will attract customers when opened. Its location is easily accessible and convenient for customers. I would not anticipate any issues with its location.

(G) The existence or absence of other retail licenses or bottle club licenses with similar privilege within the neighborhood or community of the location or the proposed licensed premises.

There are other similar businesses in the area with liquor licenses that allow for on and offsite sales.

(H) The existing motor vehicle and pedestrian traffic flow in the vicinity of the proposed licensed premises:

Although no recent traffic studies have been completed regarding motor vehicle traffic in the general area, the traffic flow is not of concern at this time nor is pedestrian traffic.

(I) The adequacy of existing law enforcement:

The Scottsbluff Police Department is allowed 33 full-time officers in the department and handled approximately 17,073 calls for service, not including traffic citations during 2021. The number of liquor licenses within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Police Department, regardless of the class, continues to be a priority to the Police Department, and even routine monitoring of their business practices is difficult. Compliance checks continue to remain a concern to those businesses that sell

alcohol to minors. The Nebraska State Patrol has assumed liquor law enforcement duties, and their wide jurisdiction generally precludes any particular focus in the city.

(J) Whether the type of business or activity proposed to be operated in conjunction with the proposed license is and will be consistent with the public interest:

Adequate staffing and training, as well as close supervision of patrons, are important. Cooperation with the Police Department by management will help to eliminate or diminish potential problems with violations.

The owners of Montez Liquor have applied for a new license in the name of Olga Montelongo.

The Development Services Department is required by Article 1, Chapter 11 of the Scottsbluff Municipal Code to report specific information to the Mayor and City Council whenever a liquor license application hearing is held. In accordance with that directive the following information is offered:

- (1) The property at 1311 E. Overland is situated in a C-3 (Heavy Commercial) zoning district where retail stores and services are allowed by right pursuant to the City's Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 25, of the City's Municipal Code of Ordinances. The properties to the north are zoned R-1a (Single Family Medium Density) and the properties to the east, south and west are zoned C-3 (Heavy Commercial).
- (2) The off-street parking requirements are 1 space for every 250 square feet of building space is required for retail use. The building has 600 square feet of retail space. The occupancy will need access to at least 3 off street parking spaces as required by ordinance. This requirement is found in 25-5-1 (18) of the City's Municipal Code of Ordinances.
- (3) The use of this property is consistent with the C-3 zone.
- (4) The Lakota Lutheran Center is situated within approximately 290 feet from the subject property.
- (5) The existing population of Scottsbluff is approximately 14,282.

The City of Scottsbluff Liquor License Holders Investigatory Board met in a regular meeting on Wednesday, February 1, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. in the Meeting Room of City Hall, 2525 Circle Drive, Scottsbluff. A notice of the meeting had been published on January 27, 2023 in the Star Herald, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the city. The notice stated the date, hour and place of the meeting, that the meeting would be open to the public. That anyone with a disability desiring reasonable accommodation to attend the meeting should contact the city clerk's office, and that an agenda of the meeting kept continuously current was available for public inspection at the office of the city clerk in City Hall; provided, the committee could modify the agenda at the meeting if it determined that an emergency so required. A similar notice, together with a copy of the agenda, also had been delivered to each committee member.

- Roll Call The following Board Members were present: Russ Knight, Chairman; Andrea Margheim, Member; Kevin Spencer; Police Chief/City Manager; Kim Wright, City Clerk; and Matt Huck, Scottsbluff Public Schools. Absent: Kelli Larson, Panhandle Prevention Coalition and Libby Stobel City Attorney
- 2. Open Meeting Act Chairman Knight welcomed everyone in attendance and informed those in attendance that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act is posted on the west wall for the public's review.
- 3. Call Meeting to Order The meeting was called to order and Wright recorded the proceedings.
- 4. Changes or additions to the agenda None.
- 5. Approve the July 20, 2022 Regular Meeting Minutes Motion by Margheim, second by Spencer to approve the July 20, 2022 Regular Meeting Minutes, motion passed unanimously.
- 6. New Application.
 - a. Ms. Olga and Mr. Jose Montelongo were present to answer questions regarding the Class D Liquor License Application for Montez Liquor, LLC d/b/a Montez Liquor, 1311 East Overland, Scottsbluff, NE. Ms. Montelongo explained they decided to purchase the business after they saw it was for sale; they currently have a trucking business and rentals, adding they have been in the community for 45 years.

Police Chief Spencer asked if they had any experience in the alcohol industry. Ms. Montelongo stated they have no experience; however, her family will help her run the business and they all are taking the alcohol training offered by the State. There are five family members that will help with the business that will be open seven days a week from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Ms. Montelongo also commented in the future they will probably be open on the weekends until 11:00 or 12:00 p.m., noting the business has 9-

10 security cameras located inside, around the cooler, freezer and front desk. There are cameras located outside as well.

Chairman Knight asked who would be ordering the inventory for the business. Ms. Montelongo answered it would either be herself or her two sons, who are over the age of 21. All overstock is kept in a freezer in a different room and brought out to a cooler as needed.

Ms.Montelongo was asked what would happen if an employee sold to a minor. She stated the employee would be retrained and not allowed behind the register for a period of time. She did mention she has a Point of Sale machine on order as the one that was there previously was not working. At this time, they are checking ID's and have a driver's license book available for reference.

Committee Member Margheim moved, seconded by Mr. Spencer to make a positive recommendation to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission regarding the Class D Liquor License for Montez Liquor, LLC d/b/a Montez Liquor. Motion passed unanimously.

7. Liquor License Compliance Issue

- Git N Split Ms. Becky Fulton, manager with Git N Split came forward to explain their compliance violation. Ms. Fulton explained the employee did not ID the customer and they are no longer employed with the business. She went on to state the current seven employees have taken the RBST training and she brought along copies of their certificates. Mr. Knight asked if they have corporate training since this seems to be a pattern; they have had violations in the past. Ms. Fulton stated she would check with corporate to see what could be done.
- Maverik Manager Carolyn was present and stated she stresses carding everyone, especially now since the violation. She added with their violation the employee typed their own birthdate in the POS system to override the machine. The employee has since been let go and is no longer working there. She also commented all new hires are required to take computer-based alcohol and tobacco management courses.
- Panhandle Coop Manager Eric King and Marketing Director Susan Wiedeman were present to discuss the violation. Mr. King stated the associate carded the customer, but punched her own birthdate in the machine. They have a zerotolerance policy and the employee was terminated. Since the violation, all liquor and front end employees have been retrained with Lanette Richards from Monument Prevention Coalition.
- Cigarette Chain A representative declined to come to the meeting.

8.	The meeting adjourned at 2:45 p.m. with a motion by Margheim and second by Sper Motion passed unanimously.
