FOLLOW-UP ON THE COST OF INSTALLING PEDESTRIAN ACTIVATED ILLUMINATED LIGHTING AT THE CROSSWALK BETWEEN JACKSON AVE AND BRADFORD ST., PER COUNCILMEMBER KAMPRATH'S REQUEST - Bruce Smith

Administrative Report: On June 16, 2015, Council approved the plan for the City providing extra lighting, reflective signage, and relocation of the crosswalk on N. Columbia Ave. to the middle of the block between Jackson Ave and Bradford St., conditional upon investigating the cost of installing pedestrian activated illuminated lighting around the pedestrian sign at the crosswalk prior to implementing the proposed plan.

Street Superintendent Aldrich received a quote from a sign company for flashing pedestrian signs for the crosswalk. The cost for a solar, flashing sign is \$1,495 each or \$2,980 for the two signs. The cost for the standard TFG Diamond Grade sign is \$84.51 each or \$169.02. Roger Reamer at the Hospital stated he is fine with using the standard signs.

Following review and discussion, direction to staff or a motion to move forward with the recommended high-grade reflective pedestrian crossing signage (TFG Diamond Grade) would be in order.
