3. ELECTION OF COUNCIL PRESIDENT

Councilmember Pike nominated Chris Schmit as Council President. By written ballot, Councilmember Schmit was elected President.

4. UPDATE ON LOCAL EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN ORIENTATION & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES

Emergency Management Director Gary Petersen was present to review the Local Emergency Operations Plan, which includes guidelines for handling disasters. This plan was recently updated. Information presented included the following: Having a different responsible person in each area, i.e., if one person holds too many responsibilities, after the third day during a disaster, burnout occurs; Mayor and Council have control during a disaster, with the appointment of a public information officer, so that all information goes through one person for correctness; After first disaster declaration is signed, an entity is eligible for possible State and Federal funding resources; Debris management is very important after a disaster (designating a place to store, sort, manage-usually city-owned property such as a ball field, storage area, etc.; Donation management should be considered, with funds going to City (which then are used by City to assist with City repairs); Church organizations,

Salvation Army and other local groups are important in disaster relief (food, generators, services); Volunteer management, with National Guard assisting to seal the disaster area and setting up a center so looting and theft does not occur--Volunteer Fire Depts. can also be useful in this area; A long-term recovery team is helpful; Funding may be available (75%-25% cost share) for purchase of sirens.

Mr. Petersen continued that on January 11, 2016, a tabletop exercise for all surrounding communities will be held at the Seward County Ag Pavilion to assist with discussion-based exercises on tornadoes or other types of disasters (natural, hazardous-materials-based, etc.) He also stated that signs posted at rural residences will be replaced, since the first signs installed have faded, due to manufacturing defects.

Councilmember Schmit inquired if the emergency plan was listed online, to which Mr. Petersen responded that it was not, since individual phone numbers are private information.

Mr. Petersen was thanked for his informative update.

5. REQUEST FOR PUBLIC FINANCE PROPOSALS & QUALIFICATIONS FOR PURCHASE OF SEWARD COUNTRY CLUB

Administrator Smith explained that the City will be soliciting proposals from interested firms for tax-exempt public financing for the proposed purchase of the assets of the Seward Country Club. The purchase price is \$350,000.00, with the City seeking a seven-year loan/bond.

Moved by Councilmember Beck, seconded by Councilmember Fritz, to approve the Request for Public Finance Proposals and Qualifications (RFP/RFQ) for taxexempt public financing of the proposed purchase of the assets of the Seward County Club for \$350,000.00 for a seven-year loan/bond.

Ordinance No. 2015-17 amending the Comprehensive Pay Plan effective January 1, 2016 and adding Golf Shop Manager, Golf Course Supt. and Golf Shop Seasonal Employee was passed.

Councilmember Fritz moved, seconded by Councilmember Pike, that the minutes of the proceedings of the Mayor and Council of the City of Seward, Seward County, Nebraska in the matter of passing and approving Ordinance No. 2015-17, "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR CLASSIFICATION OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF SEWARD, NEBRASKA; TO PROVIDE FOR LONGEVITY PAY AND PAYMENT OF PART-TIME EMPLOYEES; TO PROVIDE FOR A DATE SUCH CLASSIFICATION AND PAY RANGES OF COMPENSATION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM; TO PROVIDE FOR A TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT", be preserved and kept in a separate and distinct volume known as "Ordinance Record, City of Seward, Nebraska" and that said separate and distinct volume be incorporated in and made a part of these proceedings the same as though it were spread at large herein.

CONSIDERATION OF AWARDING BID FOR ROBERTS STREET AREA DISTRIBUTION UPGRADES - Larry Ruether & Olsson Associates Engineer Garrett Klein

Administrative Report: This project includes: 1) rebuilding approximately 5,300 feet of distribution pole line as double circuit, with 45' typical pole size and back to back 3-phase spacer cable circuits; 2) rebuilding approximately 1,600 feet of distribution pole line as double circuit; 3) replacing approximately ten pole-type distribution transformers; and, 4) rebuilding one segment of 34.5 kV pole line.

This project was originally estimated at \$450,000. On October 20, 2015, based on the engineer's recommendation to rebid the project, the City Council rejected the only bid received, which was \$692,875.

The engineer's adjusted estimate was \$504,000. The lowest bid of \$571,800 is 13% above the engineer's estimate. The bidders indicated the project is more time-consuming than the engineer projected. If awarded to the low bid, the project has a December 2016 estimated completion date. It is the intent of the City to bond the costs of this project.

Following review and discussion, a motion to award the bid to Schmader Electric in the amount of \$571,800 would be appropriate.

Mayor Eickmeier and Members of the City Council:

Bids for the subject project were opened at the Seward City Offices at 2:00 pm on Thursday, December 3, 2015. Three (3) bids were received as shown on the attached bid tabulation and summarized below:

Schmader Electric	\$ 571,800.00	Dec 31, 2016
IES Commercial, Inc	\$ 683,030.00	May 27, 2016
Ward Electric Company, Inc	\$ 790,869.00	May 31, 2016

Our estimate, presented to the City Council at the October 20, 2015 meeting, was \$504,000. The apparent low bid is 13% higher than the estimate. Based on the responses to the project's initial advertisement and the re-bid, contractors have viewed the work as more time-consuming than our estimate projected.

Olsson Associates has experience with Schmader Electric on several previous projects, including a similarly-sized contract for City of Seward in 2012. Our experience with Schmader has been favorable. It is our understanding that the Seward Light Department has been satisfied with Schmader's work.

Schmader's proposed completion date is much later than the other bidders. Though an earlier completion date would be preferred, the delay does not present any issues beyond the additional months that the existing facilities remain in service. In our opinion, the savings with the Schmader proposal compared to the other bidders is worth the delay.

Based on the bid amounts and our experience with the apparent low bidder, we recommend award of the Roberts Street Area Distribution Line Upgrades contract to Schmader Electric of West Point, Nebraska, for the bid amount of \$571,800.00.

CONSIDERATION OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 11 OF THE SEWARD CITY CODE TO RETITLE THE ARTICLE, TO ESTABLISH A GENERAL EMPLOYEES PENSION PLAN COMMITTEE AND TO APPOINT CITY COUNCIL DESIGNATED MEMBERS - Bonnie Otte

Administrative Report: The City's Police Pension Plan has a separate Committee overseeing the fiduciary responsibility of the plan. Currently, there is no Committee providing this oversight for the General Employee Pension Plan. Scott Holechek of Ameritas (Plan provider) is advising that the City consider establishing a committee for the General Employee Plan.

Attached is an ordinance that would create the General Employee Pension Plan Committee.

Following review and discussion, a motion to adopt the ordinance would be in order.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 11 OF THE SEWARD CITY CODE TO RETITLE THE ARTICLE; TO ESTABLISH A GENERAL EMPLOYEE'S PENSION PLAN COMMITTEE "COMMITTEE"; TO APPOINT THE CITY COUNCIL DESIGNATED MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL EMPLOYEE'S PENSION PLAN COMMITTEE; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEWARD AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 11 is hereby retitled: Police Pension Plan Pension Plans

Section 1. INCORPORATION OF PENSION PLAN. The restated Police Officers Pension Plan for the City of Seward, is made a part of and incorporated into this Article as fully as if set forth at length herein and that said Pension Plan be effective January 1, 1984. (A copy of this plan is on file at the office of the City Clerk).

Section 2. PENSION COMMITTEE CITY MEMBERS. The City Council designated members for the Pension Committee for the Pension Plans shall consist of the City Administrator and the Assistant Administrator/City Clerk-Treasurer/Budget & Human Resources Director and that the persons holding those offices are hereby appointed and empowered to perform all administrative duties not specifically delegated, by ordinance, to the Retirement Committee.

SECTION 3. GENERAL EMPLOYEE'S RETIREMENT PLAN COMMITTEE; GENERAL PROVISIONS is hereby established in the following manner:

There shall be one representative from each of the following City Departments: City Hall Administration, Park/Cemetery/Recreation, Building Inspection/Public Facilities/Civic Center/Senior Center, Street, Electric, Water/Wastewater, and Library on said "Committee". Each representative must be a full-time employee currently participating in the City's General Employee's Retirement Plan. Representatives shall serve a two-year term, with establishment of the first "Committee" members in January, 2016. Initially, representatives of the City Hall Administration, Park/Cemetery/Recreation, Building Inspection/Public Facilities/Civic Center/Senior Center departments shall serve a three-year term and representatives of the Street, Electric Water/Wastewater, and Library shall serve a two-year term. The Representative shall be the voice for the respective department, gain additional knowledge about retirement plans and investments, and be the spokesperson back to the department and peers.

The "Committee" shall meet at least annually, or more often as deemed necessary, for the purpose of, but not limited to: selecting an array of appropriate investment options; monitor investment options; monitor the activities of prudent experts; document the investment review process and decisions, to develop and review an Investment Policy Statement.

The "Committee" shall annually elect a Chairperson and a Secretary from among the representatives. The Chairperson shall preside over all Pension Committee meetings and the Secretary shall give notice of all meetings and prepare written minutes of which a final copy shall be kept on file in the office of Assistant Administrator/Clerk-Treasurer/Budget & Human Resources Director. All members of the "Committee" have voting rights.

SECTION 4. REPEAL. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. WHEN OPERATIVE; PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication or posting as required by law.

CONSIDERATION OF A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING DEVELOPER AND BUILDER OR HOMEOWNER CONSTRUCTION FEES - John Hughes

Administrative Report: In May, 2007, the City established "Aid to Construction Fees" for the Electric Dept. Prior to this date, the City was not charging a developer fee to assist with offsetting the cost of costs for wire, transformers and related materials for developments. These costs were absorbed by the general rate-payer. However, the Electric Department also uses the term "Aid to Construction" for a different purpose and it was confusing to the developers.

The changes from the current resolution include: 1) Fee name changed from "Aid to Construction Fee" to "Developer and Builder or Homeowner Construction Fee"; 2) Removed Commercial fees of \$400; 3) Added the Note indicating \$100 per each 100 amps of service.

After review and discussion, a motion to adopt the resolution would be in order.

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seward, Nebraska may by resolution fix the amount of fees charged by the City of Seward Utilities, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to establish <u>Developer and Builder or</u> Homeowner Construction Fees for the Electric Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEWARD, NEBRASKA THAT:

The amount of <u>Developer and Builder or Homeowner Construction Fees</u> for the Electric Department shall henceforth be and are hereby fixed as follows to be in full force and effect on and after January 1, 2016:
