Minutes of Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners Meeting April 5, 2016

The Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, April 5, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. in the Courthouse at Le Center, Minnesota. Those members present were: John King, Dave Gliszinski, Steve Rohlfing, Lance Wetzel and Joe Connolly. Darrell Pettis and Brent Christian were also present.

On motion by Connolly, seconded by Wetzel and unanimously approved, the Board approved the agenda for the business of the day.

On motion by Wetzel, seconded by Gliszinski and unanimously approved, the Board approved the consent agenda:
