**Luke-** Sorry that I wasn't able to also join in yesterday's discussion as I was sick at home with a 24-HR bug. We cannot unfortunately make any post-bid adjustments prior to award. Here's some additional questions that we'd like to confirm with the Landscape Contractors before making any award recommendations. The aim here is to confirm scope coverage and if these items cannot be included within the bid price received, then it would in both parties interest if you were to send me back an e-mail requesting to rescind your bid (without taking your bid bond)... please respond to each of the following:

- 1. The native grass specifications indicate a plugs density of 300 plugs / 1,000 SF... please confirm that you've included the plugs for native grass seeded areas within your base bid. Moreover, please advise on if you believe this density is of sufficient coverage or not. Not included
- 2. Please confirm that you've carried a <u>qualified</u> native seeding company (Art. 1.6.C of spec. 39-9500) as specified, within your base bid. Not if you need a certain degree or certification to be considered qualified. What is considered qualified? We install sod, seeding, hydroseeding turf and natives on a weekly basis.
- 3. Please confirm that you've included within your base bid, a 3 year warranty for the native seeding and also 1 year of maintenance (as specified). Yes

- 4. The plantings details on sheet L300 and the specifications indicate planting soil requirements. Although top soil is by others, planting soil is included within the BP2-32C base bid. Please confirm that you've included planting soil within your bid. No, however have you had jobs when this was actually 100% implemented? Typically there is finish grading done with black soil throughout and if we need to add some to that we do with what is spec, but usually all the grading is finished prior to our arrival on these commercial jobs, and there is not room for us to install any additional soil in the planting beds if we account for rock or mulch too. Otherwise, we need to haul out all the finished grade black dirt to haul in new spec soil and do another final grading. So its hard to deal with this soil issue, since its always unclear as to what the final grade will look like until its done. Typically we ask the contractor what they expect, but in this case we bid this after you were not accepting questions.
- 5. It's understood that the rock mulch specified is a "Dresser Trap Rock" and exceptions aren't noted. Please confirm that you've included "Dresser Trap Rock" for rock mulch within your bid. Yes
- 6. Please confirm that you've included 3/16" steel edging (or better if specified) within your bid and clarify the extents of coverage. Yes
- 7. Please confirm that you've included the Category 4 (coconut) seed blanketing and the Category 3 (straw) seed blanketing as required. No, We were confused with wording in the specs saying to use the spec hydro mulch on the slopes and then it also called for the option of blankets for those slopes. So we did the spec hydroseeding mulch, but not erosion blankets in conjunction.
- 8. Please confirm that you understand the urgency for ordering the "big block" retaining wall materials immediately as we'd like to install this wall before this winter and we've heard Recon can have seasonal material stock that once committed, is exhausted until the following season. With whomever get's the landscaping for this project, we'd like to see this walls materials ordered in less than 30 days. Yes

Thank you for taking time to send these questions off. Again sorry for any hassle this caused.

It was nice meeting you today. After our meeting we double checked the wetland areas for "Perennial Plugs" to be planted and the quantity. We discovered that there are no wetland areas requesting this application of planting on the plans, specs, addenda's. It simply says "Native Prairie Seed Mix" around the retention pond and that is what we bid it for by application of hydroseeding. Also, it would have listed the plugs in the plant legend for the plug species and quantity, but it does not.

I know we mentioned plugs in the meeting when you asked how many we priced out, but we were thinking of another retention pond job we just bid too that was calling for those wetland plugs and so it was on our minds. See if you can come up with anything on your end contrary to what we believe was in the work scope, but we are confident that plugs were never requested for bid pricing. Its such a large area that it would be odd to install plugs around the retention pond rather than seeding it.
