The Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, August 4, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. in the Courthouse at Le Center, Minnesota. Those members present were: Steve Rohlfing, Lance Wetzel, Dave Gliszinski, John King and Joe Connolly. Darrell Pettis was also present. Brent Christian was excused.

On motion by Rohlfing, seconded by King and unanimously approved, the Board approved the agenda for the business of the day.

On motion by Gliszinski, seconded by Connolly and unanimously approved, the Board approved the consent agenda:
