Minutes of Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners Meeting October 6, 2015

The Le Sueur County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Tuesday, October 6, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. in the Courthouse at Le Center, Minnesota. On motion by Connolly, seconded by Rohlfing and unanimously approved, the Board approved the amended agenda for the business of the day.
